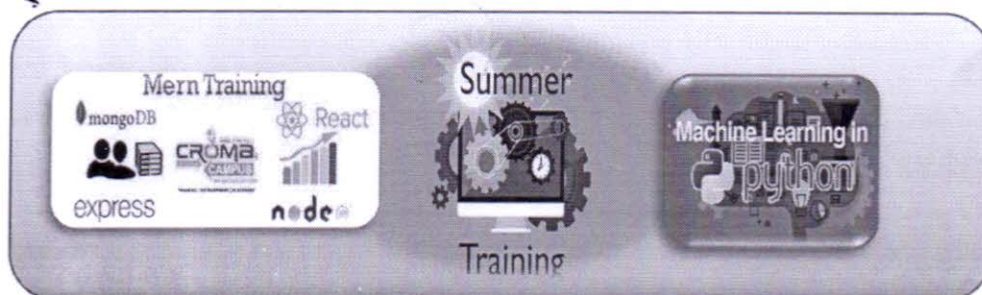

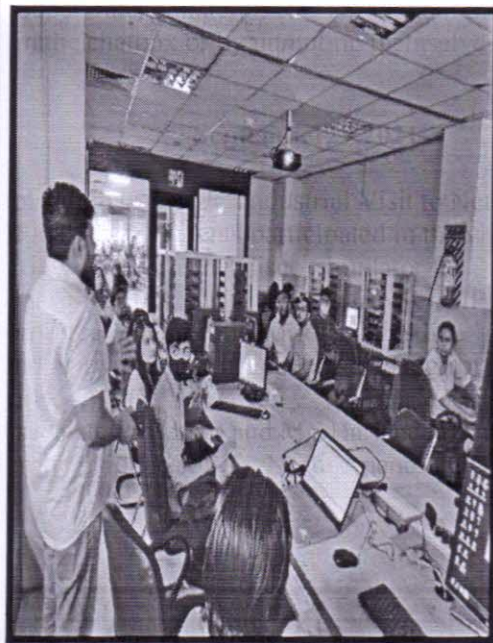
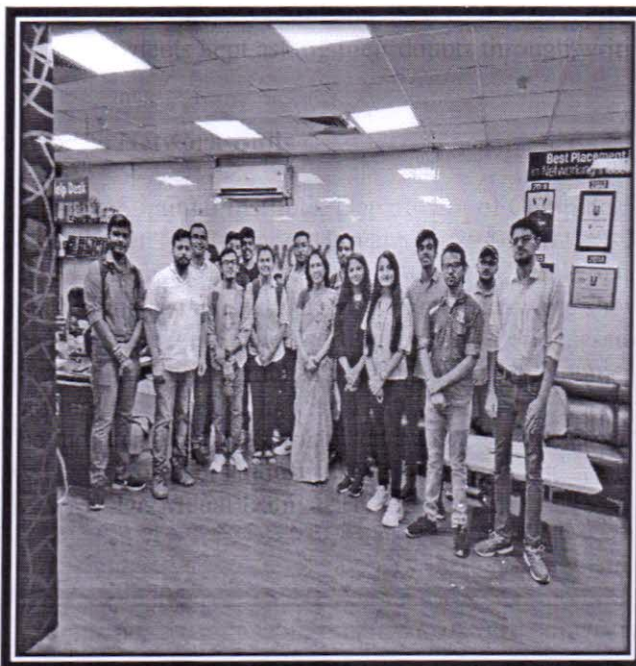

4. Industrial visit to Solar Power Plant, Budaun

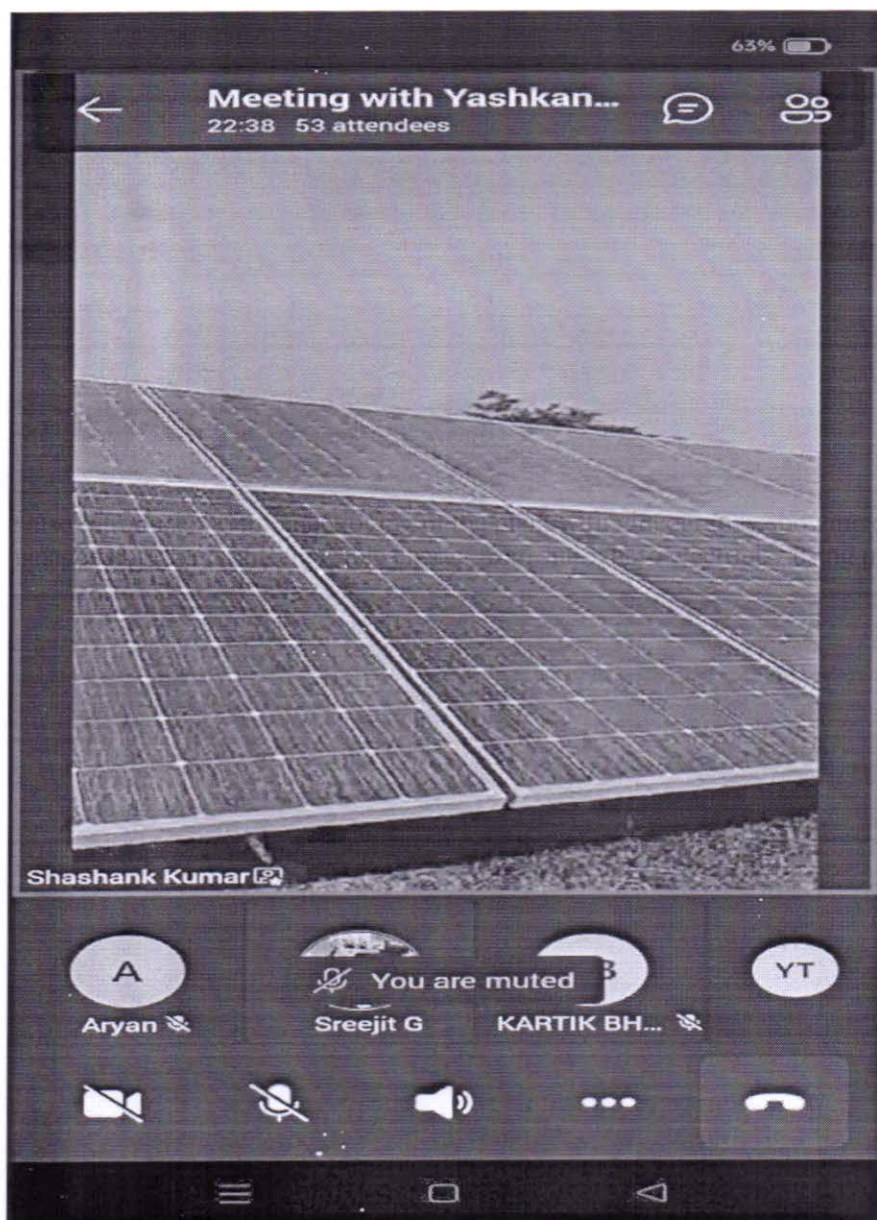
Dated: 21<sup>st</sup> Dec, 2021

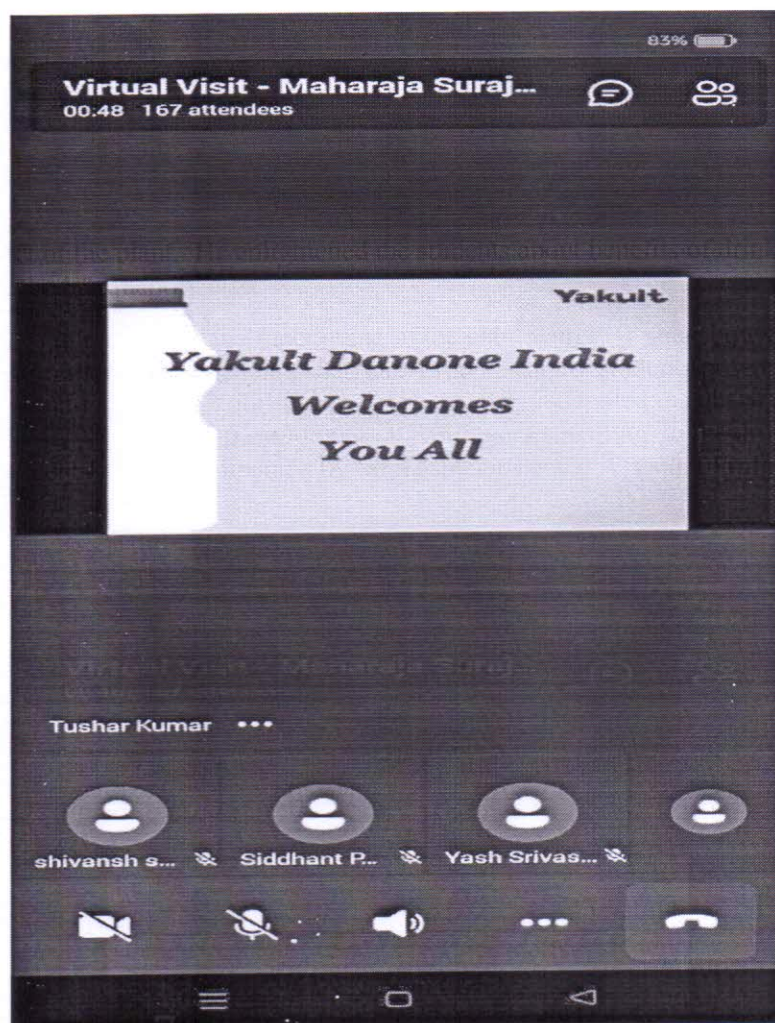

## **7. INDUSTRIAL VISIT TO MOTHER DAIRY PLANT**

**Dated: 14<sup>th</sup> June, 2022**

Maharaja Surajmal Institute, Department of Commerce organized Industrial Visit to Mother Dairy Plant, Patparganj, New Delhi-92 on **14<sup>th</sup> June 2022**. B.Com (H) first year students participated in the visit. Total 56 students participated in the event. The students were given the opportunity to be a part of a two hour virtual visit of dairy plant. Firstly a lecture was delivered by staff Coordinator, A short video displaying introduction about the plant, its Establishment, Capacity, Operations aspect of the plant. She enlightened the students about its role in fresh milk Production & Distribution as well as the processes used in manufacturing milk & milk related products.

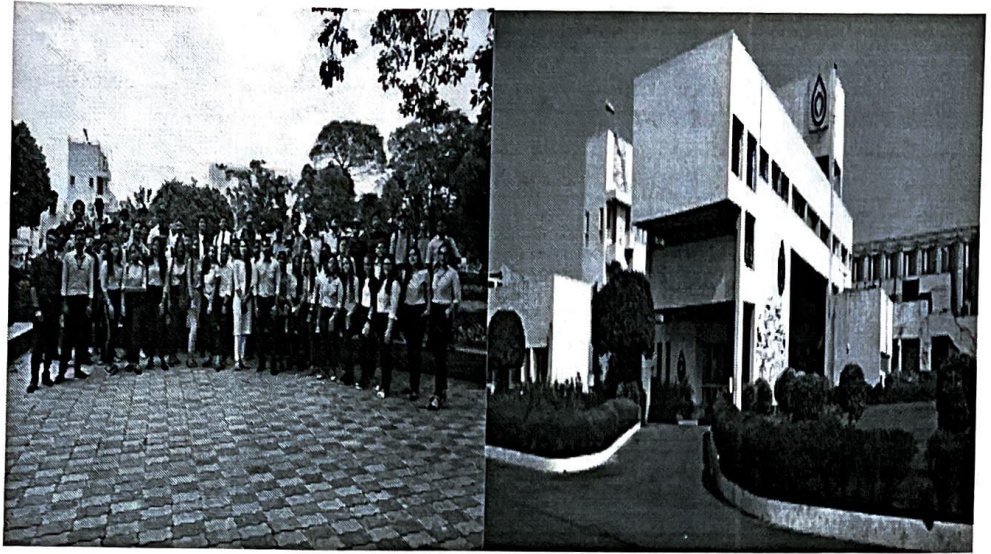
The following are some of the key highlights of the visit:

- As soon as the milk arrives from the farms, the milk undergoes 12 different quality tests and is then accepted for further processing.
- The machines are structured in a way which avoids direct human contacts with the milk during the processing and packaging period.
- The machines are cleaned after every cycle of processing with hot water.
- The plant uses Solar Heat for Industrial Processes (SHIP) to heat the water which is used for the cleaning process.
- The water used for cleaning the machineries is reused to irrigate the gardens inside the Mother Dairy Campus.
- Rain water harvesting system is also present there.
- Sanitation and hygiene is being maintained properly.

The Industrial Trip was organised by Ms. Priyanka, Assistant Professor and Mr. Yashkant Teotia, Assistant Professor, under the guidance of Dr. Preeti Malik- HOD BCOM, Honours [Both Shifts].
