Whatever I am about to write is the most brief account I could give of the ~~an~~ countless immense amount of things I went through. It doesn't include every detail, but is an attempt to sum up what happened in short. I have valid proofs for everything I am mentioning.

"To err is human, especially when it's not intentional." I, Naman Kumar Bahui, had served in NSS during my school days and was naturally inclined towards social service as I aspire to crack UPSC and serve my nation in future. Thus, I immediately enrolled in the NSS MSI cell on its very incorporation in February 2020. I worked very diligently for hours with the knowledge that this is my training for future life as an officer, as well as the government certificate that I'll have will put weight in my UPSC interview. I served the cell in various capacities as an active and enthusiastic volunteer, the Head of Operations, Head of Design, Alling leader of Empathy Alling and the Project head of Project Sanskriti, the first approved Project of NSS MSI cell, a project I gave my life and soul to, for it was very close to my heart. I worked hard day & night; made social media posts for 6 hours straight; organised big initial events like Bharat Manthan Quiz (200+ registrations), Nautya Kala Dance competition (20+ entries), Auyakta Dilli Heritage Walks; organised the combined society orientation 2020 and even took NSS cell interviews for freshers. I took initiatives whenever possible and that was my position in the cell.

However, I was very vocal about the issues in the society. For this, my friend Karishk Khandelwal, currently serving as the advisor to NSS MSI, remarked "your image is of a person who fights, so even if you are right, people hesitate to support you." I raised my voice on various issues faced by our society, some of which are:-

- (1) Deceiving the volunteers by just motivating them in the name of certificate and hours and not social service in their orientations. Not keeping this system ~~very~~ clear from the very beginning. (faced by many juniors also).
- (2) Autocratic decision-making system: I have believed in a democratic system, wherein I told "You all decide what to do in the meeting,

acceptable to me." We held 2 hour long meetings just to listen that "We are not doing this" without proper negotiation or settlements. This led to a toxic work culture, faced by me & my fellow volunteers.

(3) Members with responsible positions not showing up & doing the work they are responsible for, without even knowing the reasons. I was not the only one questioning / feeling this (I have proofs), still I was the only one caught and punished.

(4) Favoritism and nepotism in the society: Positions being offered to those in a friend circle. The ex-Head girl even tented "I know everyone's friend circle" when I requested her to think of society rather than just the friendships. She said it in a sense that she'll make sure this doesn't happen, well, this is what mostly happened.

I am also a member of Tark MSI, a society where I found warmth, comfort, true friends and mentors. It was contrary to the extreme toxic culture of NSS MSI, where everyone else was really caring and friendly. We were asked by our ex-President to use the core whatsapp group for friendly bonding and light-hearted friendly talks & discussions as well. On night of 25 January 2021, in the middle of a very light-hearted friendly talk, my friends in Tark asked about my experience in NSS MSI and I like anyone shares their experiences with their friends, in a frustrated tone shared my experience with the toxicity I have to deal with daily. It was a proper conversation with a flow of questions and answers involving a group. Without the intention of NSS MSI members reading it, I shared what questions and opinions I had before I could confront my fellow volunteers with them.

One of the members in the chat, Mr. Mayank Singh, who like me was a part of both NSS and Tark MSI (also a friendly acquaintance of mine) also bad mouthed the NSS leadership and policies in that conversation. Interestingly, the next morning everyone discovers that the chats have been leaked to NSS MSI leadership by Mr. Mayank Singh with a malafide intent, evident act of deleting everyone else's messages except ex-president & my own, framing us as if a ranting about NSS MSI. I made a mistake, it shouldn't have been a society's core group. number of times I may try to convince that the conversation

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was between friends in a way
between formal society members.
Just for ~~my opinion~~ having an opinion and sharing ^{it} with
my friends, my punishment of being 'kicked-out' of NSS ^{could go}
whole was decided before even confronting me. I ^{was} ^{in a} ^{meeting}
taken on a call wherein I was given less a chance ^{to} ^{say} ^{my} ^{things}
speak in my defense, rather all the more a chance ^{to} ^{say} ^{my} ^{things}
simply listen to abuses of a gang of five people: The ex-
boy & head girl of NSS-MSI, Mr. Prateek Joshi, Ms. Ayshi ^{Das}
and Ms. Anshika Jain, who took turns and said
condematory and demoralizing things like "YOU SHOULD BE
ASHAMED OF YOUR EXISTENCE", "YOU ARE A LITTLE PIECE OF S***",
and "NOBODY LOVES YOU". I still have a segment of that 1.5
hour long call recorded with me.

I was removed not only from NSS core, but entire NSS groups
with humiliating messages. I used to receive calls and
messages on my birthday (which was known to them) and
when I was admitted in hospital to leave the groups
they couldn't remove me from, simply for asking questions
for the society.

I was into serious DEPRESSION for the next 3 months which
affected my mental & physical health and even my 3rd semester
exams severely. I was guilty to learn the real sensitivity
of what I was questioning, yet at the same time I felt that
the magnitude of my punishment was too much and I
gathered strength to talk to Rajeshwari Malik ma'am, the
then-programme officer of NSS MSI. However, due to COVID-19
second wave, this appointment dragged till May 2021 until
finally I expressed my concern to ma'am and she acknowledged
it. Ma'am accepted my apologies and promised me to
get me back in NSS team after the batch of 2018-21 gradu-
ates, which eventually didn't happen. On the top of that,
to add fuel to the fire, my dream project was given to Mr.
Mayank Singh to serve as the Project Head immediately after
this incident, who was an equal "offender" to them in this
case. He was just rewarded at the cost of NSS core rules,
and in a way NSS leadership knew would hurt me.

I began taking spiritual therapy and catharsis. I had
FORGIVEN AND FORGOTTEN the incident and was moving ahead
in my life for the past 8 months because I had learnt a
plethora of LESSONS from this incident, which
in my future life as well.

Until recently, when the present NSS MSI &
abruptly brought up the issue again, reque
to the trauma I had faced. They tried to do everything in

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their power, and capacity and self-proclaimed authority to further humiliate not only me but my friends and society collectively as well. In short:-

- 1) They were organising a combined orientation for all MSI societies without the permission of the Director or the cultural coordinator and without even inviting all MSI societies (their orientation is itself biased and a misuse of authority).
- 2) My Society Talk MSI had no information and our President was added to the group by a third party, at a time we could still be accommodated comfortably.
- 3) Mr. Prateek and Ms. Aysli claimed that NSS MSI won't present their orientation if Talk MSI presents theirs in the event, naming me in bold to be the reason.
- 4) Firstly Talk MSI is a proud member of all MSI societies. It did not have any problem with NSS MSI and it was out of NSS MSI leadership's jurisdiction to debar us from rightfully presenting our orientation in that event.
- 5) Not only this, they removed Talk's President Jami Pamiya from the group following this. They created undue pressure on us by convincing societies with their friends as leaders to deny Talk its right in my name, a group's - in fact they've always followed.
- 6) They tried doing whatever was in their control, be it related to NSS, Talk, or our conflict or not. Eg. Prateek removed me from the common CR group of MSI for our batch, though I am the CR of my class.

This issue was taken up to the cultural coordinator with a hope for justice, however, few attempts were rendered fruitless and this was delayed due to unforeseen reasons. I realized how much their actions were affecting me when simply hearing their voice SHOT UP MY PULSE RATE & BP, my MUSCLES STARTED TWITCHING and I felt so ALONE in this PANIC AND ANXIETY ATTACK.

I had to leave my home and go out of town so that it doesn't affect my family as it had been doing for the past 1 year because they couldn't see me like this. I had been stopping my family & friends from intervening, thinking it's a college issue and not a school one. But thanks to them I am able to convey all this now because of them only. Due to anxiety and stress, I FAINTED in Jaipur. My CONDITION WAS MANIFESTING GROSSLY IN MY P.

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Finally the President of Tark, Janvi Pahuja had a word with Mr. Prateek Toshii and Mr. Kyil Goyal on a personal level. I was informed that Mr. Prateek began shouting in an uncivilized manner in the beginning of the meeting. He demanded an 'apology' from my side, which was quite forceful. He explicitly demanded that I mustn't attend the common orientation, meant for all MSI students, even as a spectator, as if I am NOT EVEN AN MSI STUDENT. It seems as if he would chuck me off even the college if he could.

In the Indian legal system, there is a provision of punishing the offender ONLY, that too only ONCE for the crime committed. But here, they clearly punished me again and again for the same "crime", that too much more than I deserved. These incidents have costed me very dearly - my confidence, positions, peace of mind, performance and even my FAITH IN MY COLLEGE. I even thought of approaching the POLICE and filing an official complaint to get justice, but the thought of my college's prestige stopped me. When things went out of control, I even considered SUICIDE to end this pain and agony, thanks to my spiritual background I could stop myself.

Ms. Aysli Das and I have been placed in the same company, IHS Markit and will be representing our college over there, however, with this attitude of her, I don't think it is going to be a good experience. There is no more to it, however, I'll sum it up requesting strict action against the following:-

- (i) Mr. Prateek Toshii, BBA(G) V-A, 1st shift
- (ii) ~~Ms.~~ Aysli Das, BBA(G) V-A, 1st shift
- (iii) Ms. Anshika Jain, BBA(G), V-B, 1st shift
- (iv) Mr. Mayank Singh, BBA(G), V-B, 1st shift

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The best practice I have seen while growing up in my school days is that those who have abused and misused their power and authority, their authority and power is withdrawn and this is what should be done ideally in this case as well. There are a lot many things that my wellwishers and I would love to demand, but I'll end this letter here in a hope for a befitting action.
