



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

#### STRESS MANAGEMENT WEBINAR REPORT


In accordance with the institute's initiative to conduct interactive sessions with their students.

The COVID-19 pandemic is a crisis unlike any other country before. The constantly evolving situation may create significant stress and uncertainty. Many of us are dealing with constant stress due to this crisis in our country.

To overcome this stress and anxiety, an interactive session on stress management was organized by STUDENT COUNSELING COMMITTEE, MAHARAJA SURAJMAL INSTITUTE, JANAKPURI for the BCOM I Semester students (both shift) on Saturday, 5 feb 2022 from 11am-12noon on an online platform. We were joined by a distinguished guest, Dr Lovleen Malhotra maám, who was the eminent speaker of the session, a psychologist cum medical counsellor.

The session started out with an introduction and a welcome speech given to our guest, by teacher Ms. Chetna Grewal (BCOM Department), then Dr. Lovleen kickstarted the session by asking what sort of psychological issues or mental health problems, like anxiety or stress, were the students facing during this phase. To this they promptly replied, that they were facing obstacles such as long hours of online classes throughout the week, procrastination, being cooped up under the same roof due to lockdown, and suffering the loss of a close one due to Covid. She had a very optimistic approach while answering all the students' queries and emphasized on moving on from the past and prioritizing the present, living it to the fullest. She discussed that how Stress directly leads to anxiety which affect our daily life. Another question raised that how stress led to bad habits/addiction. To this ma'am replied that socializing, connecting with each other, playing games especially with friends, could prove to be a real stressbuster too but there are fair restrictions on the time limit. Overthinking, a common practice among individuals is more inclined to be personality trait than a side-effect of stress, according to ma'am. It can be avoided by incorporating mindclearing habits in one's life, such as meditating, getting a fresh breath of air in a park or even a terrace, listening to good music and having a fun hobby to distract yourself with. These tips also help to expel negative thoughts from the mind and inculcate these good habits to promote positive thinking. She told many ways to relieve stress and the most important way she told is about how one can talk about their emotions in a better way. She ended the session by stressing on to the importance of loving yourself and keeping an optimistic mindset in the long run.




#### **JANUARY 2022**


#### Mentor-Mentee Meet
