Criteria 7.1.3: (A)

(a) Solid waste management.

The college has implemented a solid waste management system which involves segregation of wet, dry, biomedical, paper and green waste, setting up of dustbins of different colours.

(b) Biomedical waste management

Due to the nature of the courses taught, no biomedical waste material is produced in the institute.

(c) E-waste management

In order to manage the E-waste the institute has a scheme through which electronic and computer accessories which are declared "obsolete" are exchanged with new equipment under buy back scheme and also old computers are donated to a school in Shamli. Also, the Institute outsources the maintenance and repairing of IT infrastructure such as Computers, Printers, LAN facilities, Modems, Routers, Internet facilities including Wi-Fi and Broadband. It is monitored by Convener, Lab Maintenance Committee.

(d) Hazardous chemicals and radioactive waste management.

Due to the nature of the courses taught, no hazardous waste material is produced in the institute. Radioactive waste in batteries is disposed under the exchange and buy back scheme.

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
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Different Colour Dustbins for Solid Waste Management




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
